

Program Benefits

- Antigua and Barbuda citizenship offers visa-free or visa-on-arrival access to over 150 countries.
- The program has flexible investment options, including donations, real estate, and business investments.

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for citizenship the main applicant must be over 18 years of age, meet the application requirements, and select one of the following 4 options available:

- A minimum donation of USD 230,000 to the National Development Fund is required for a single applicant.
- Real estate investment of at least USD 300,000 in an approved project qualifies for citizenship. The investment must be maintained for a minimum of five years.
- USD 260,000 non-refundable contribution to the University of the West Indies Fund.
- A business investment of USD 1.5 million in an eligible business.



Procedures and Timelines

The process for Antigua and Barbuda Citizenship by Investment typically takes 3 to 6 months. The application can include family members, such as spouses, dependent children under 30, and dependent parents. The investor is required to visit Antigua for a minimum of five days in the first five years to maintain citizenship.
