INVESTMENT OPTIONS

ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTION

A minimum contribution of US\$115,000 applies to a single applicant under the Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Program. An additional contribution of US\$2,000 is required for each qualifying dependent included in the application. The contribution supports national climate resilience and sustainable development initiatives, forming the basis of the applicant's eligibility for citizenship.

ADDITIONAL FEES

In addition to the qualifying investment, applicants should anticipate costs related to advisory, government processing, official documentation, certification, due diligence and administrative services. 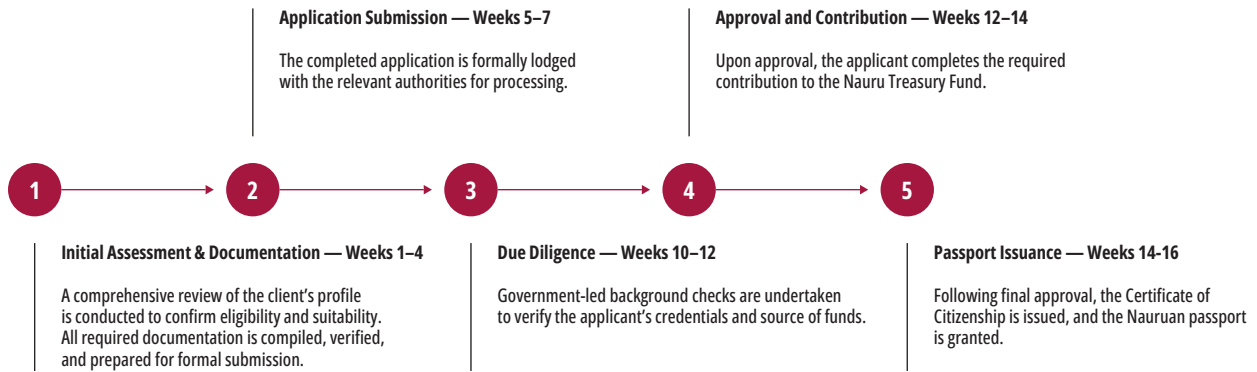

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To qualify for the Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Program, applicants must be at least 18 years of age, maintain a clean personal and professional background, and provide clear evidence of the legitimate source of funds. Applicants are also required to fulfill the prescribed contribution requirements in accordance with the program's regulations.
